1994 saw the implementation of the Directive in the United Kingdom. In drafting the regulations elements of both German and French law were drawn upon, in particular the French method of compensation and the German indemnity method, for calculating damages.

The UK had no prior tradition of protecting commercial agents, and in certain judgments since implementation, the French method of compensation has been drawn upon. Our speakers will examine the current legal position in their respective jurisdictions, and in particular the influence of French and German practise on the position in England and Wales.
